The Misuse of Drugs - Google Books Result In the UK, it has been estimated that around 4 million people use illicit drugs each year, with cannabis by far the most commonly used, followed by cocaine and ecstasy (Roe & Man, 2006). Opioid misuse occurs on a smaller scale but is associated with much greater rates of harm than either cocaine or cannabis.
